Once you determine what kind of application you want, you need to decide how to get them the information about the programs they are applying to and scholarship options/rules.

How will the candidates learn about the programs offered by CareerDash?

In our experience, it's better if the candidate comes to their interviews knowing about the courses, which career they are interested in, and the process before actually submitting their application.
